
IMPLEMENTING IPADS IN THE EARLY YEARS

ADVANCED IPAD TRAINING



"Focusing on single-purpose skill apps to "get people started" is a mistake." Embrace the multi-purpose evergreen apps.

"The opportunity to teach and learn with iPads can be extremely powerful for you and your students."

"When you empower kids from the beginning to create meaningful work and share it to inform, persuade, and inspire others, you help students see themselves as thinkers, authors, and creators whose ideas and knowledge have genuine purpose."

"Then, you begin a shift in your classroom that gives students ownership over their learning and authentic voice beyond the school walls. That's one of the greatest benefits of classroom technology. Head in that direction from the very beginning, and there's no limit to where you can go."

DESIGNING WORKFLOWS

A workflow is the series of steps you use when creating content on the iPad.

For example, in a creating a digital story in the MyStory app, you may have to:

- 1. write the story
- 2. take pictures with the camera
- draw in the Sketches app
- 4. add pictures, text, and other content to the pages
- 5. publish the completed story

KEY QUESTIONS

After some practice, will kids be able to do this independently?

KEY QUESTIONS

Do I have a supportive classroom culture that promotes student sharing and collaboration?

KEY QUESTIONS

Do I have systems in place to ensure student privacy, and to ensure compliance with any school or district policies pertaining to online publishing? (For example, we never post photos of students that are identified by their name.)



CREATE DIFFERENTIATED INSTRUCTIONAL INFOSNACKS

using apps like explain everything, you can make Instructional videos for your class

RECORD STUDENT THINKING

using apps like explain everything, draw and tell, or even puppet pals, you can capture student thinking as they engage with the app

CREATE MULTIMODAL STUDENT ARTIFACTS

using apps like my story or puppet pals, students can combine visuals and audio in their work

They can narrate stories, make narrated puppet shows, etc







USING QR CODES WITH IMAGES

• to use QR codes with images, the image must be located on the web and have a web address

TWO OPTIONS:

- upload your image to a website such as dropbox, or google drive
- use images that pre-exist on the web (google image search)

OBTAINING IMAGE ADDRESSES

DROPBOX:

- from the computer- scroll down to the picture you want to link. On the far right hand side is a link icon.
 Click on this to get the link.
- from the iPad- in the dropbox app, tap on the photo, then tap on the "share" icon (the box and arrow), then tap "copy link"

OBTAINING IMAGE ADDRESSES

- THE WEB (GOOGLE SEARCH):
 - from the computer- right click on an image, select copy image address
 - from the iPad- press and hold on an image, select copy, then paste in the desired location.







USING QR CODES WITH AUDIO

- Visit http://vocaroo.com from a compouter and record audio. (As of yet, you cannot do this with your iPad)
- Save the image of your QR code the website generates.
- Print the image and post it anywhere in your classroom!

EXTENSION: CREATING SOCIAL STORIES


WHAT IS A SOCIAL STORY?

Social Stories are a concept devised by Carol Gray in 1991 to improve the social skills of people with autism spectrum disorders (ASD). Social stories are used to educate and as praise.

CREATING SOCIAL STORIES

- 1. Select the target behavior you want to be the focus of the story.
- 2. Your first page should be the title with an appropriate picture.
- 3. The next pages will be the story script. The story should be written from the perspective of a child. Keep the wording simple and short (no more than two pages). You should use actual photographs of items, people, places from the child's life if possible. Complex ideas should be broken into smaller steps.
- 4. Add audio to the pages, narrating the social story.




